## Coronavirus prevention measures

Due to the coronavirus, measures have been established in public transport to prevent contagion.

### General recommendations

The health authorities have established measures to prevent contagion from the virus. It is necessary to comply with the generic protection measures against any respiratory disease:

The use of a mask is mandatory while using public transport, both inside vehicles and at stations, stops and corridors. Gloves are also recommended.

- Wash your hands frequently (with soap and water or 70% alcoholic solutions), especially after direct contact with sick people or their surroundings.
- Cover your mouth and nose with disposable tissues or the inside of your elbow when coughing or sneezing, and wash your hands immediately.
- Avoid close contact with people who suffer from acute respiratory infections and who exhibit coughs, sneezes or expectorations.
- Avoid sharing food, belongings and other objects without cleaning them properly.
- Try to keep a safe distance from other public transport users.
- When you exit public transport, wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water or with an hydroalcoholic gel as soon as possible.
- Avoid using public transport if you feel unwell or belong to a risk group. Do not travel under any circumstances if you have been diagnosed with coronavirus or if you have any symptoms compatible with the disease.
- The recommendations established by the health authorities must be followed at all times.

### In the Metro

- The metro schedule, until further notice, is from Monday to Sunday from 5 a.m. to 12 a.m.
- Make an orderly and patient queue at the entrances and exits of railway and metro stations.
- Make room for the user in front of you when you validate your ticket.
- In the stations, when you walk through the corridors, do it on your right, leaving room for users who are walking in the opposite direction.

- On escalators and conveyor belts, keep a single row, without moving ahead of those in front of you.
- Do not occupy elevators to their maximum capacity.
- On the platform, leave a large amount of room in front of the doors and allow users that are leaving to do so in comfort. Go in avoiding clusters of people.
- While you wait on the platform for the arrival of the metro, spread out over its entire length to maintain maximum distance from other users.
- Inside the metro, spread out over the entire length of the carriage. In accordance with the new regulations, all seats can now be occupied.
- The opening of doors is being carried out automatically in all the train series that technically allow it.
- Cleaning and disinfection measures on trains and stations have been reinforced.

## **Bus**

- The sale of transport tickets has been eliminated. Tickets can be purchased in the [online sales section of the website](#), in the [TMB App](#), at the metro distributors or at some bus stops.
- [You can buy single bus tickets](#) and validate them from the TMB App. These are digital tickets that you carry on your mobile and you can validate them directly through the QR code that you will find on board TMB buses.
- Entrance to the bus will be through the rear doors. Inside the bus, in accordance with the new regulations, all seats can now be occupied.
- All possible service is being given with the available personnel and following the criteria of the administrative authorities.
- At bus stops, leave ample space in front of the doors and allow users who are getting off to do so in comfort. Go in avoiding clusters of people: the driver will wait.
- No service: bus lines 102, 103 and 104 have stopped providing service until further notice.
- Cleaning and disinfection measures have been reinforced on buses with the use of ozone cannons.

## **Barcelona Bus Turístic**

- Hygiene and safety measures.
- It is mandatory to wear a mask.
- Hygiene and disinfection measures on buses have been reinforced.
- We put at your disposal a disinfection point with hydroalcoholic gel.

The regular Bus Turístic is not in service, except for the Barcelona Panoràmica route.

## **Barcelona Panoràmica service**

- Service hours: from July 10<sup>th</sup> to August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- Days of service: Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- Departure times (three daily services): 4 p.m., 6 p.m. and 8 p.m.
- Starting point: Passeig de Colom - Port Vell (Barcelona Bus Turístic stop).
- Approximate duration: 1 h and 50 min.
- Arrival at the meeting point: 20 minutes before departure.

- Guaranteed seat with a reservation.
- New guided service with a live tour guide, adapted to the local client, in Catalan and Spanish.
- Double-decker open-top bus.

### Montjuïc Cable Car:

- It is mandatory to wear a mask both inside the cabins and in the rest of the facilities.
- Try to keep a safe distance from other users.
- We control seating capacity in the facilities.
- We have reinforced the hygiene and disinfection measures of the cabins and the rest of the facilities to guarantee your safety.
- We put at your disposal disinfection points for your hands.

### Real-time information: occupancy levels in the metro and bus

To **facilitate trip planning** and avoid crowds, you have at your disposal an application that shows indicators of the estimated average occupation level.






You can check the information by line, direction, station and time slot for the metro; and by line, direction and time slot for the bus.

The data shows average estimates. The estimated occupancy levels could change in the event of unforeseen incidents in the service.

When you check your line, the system will show you the estimated average occupancy level for the day and time you are checking. If you want to check other days or time slots, you can easily do so with the configuration options.
