TMB filming and transport regulations – Bus – Metro Barcelona Bus Turístic, Montjuïc cable car and Funicular Montjuïc de TMB

- The film crew (including technical and artistic crew) must not consist of more than 4 people.
- Their details must be duly entered on the filming application form.
- Tickets must be validated to access any part of the TMB transport network.
- All crew members, including the director, must be registered with JoTMBé. For runner-up or winning films, TMB will always contact the person who uploaded them.
- Filming permits are not required to shoot at bus stops, Barcelona Bus Turístic stops or outside metro stations.
- **You will need to apply for a permit if you wish to shoot your film in any of the following places:**
 - **Metro facilities and interiors**
 - **Bus interiors**
 - **Barcelona Bus Turístic interiors**
 - **Montjuïc cable car facilities or interiors**
 - **Montjuïc funicular railway station or interior**

1. In all metro, bus, Montjuïc funicular railway, Barcelona Bus Turístic and Montjuïc cable car facilities and interiors:

- You will need to apply for a filming permit **72 calendar hours in advance, counting from the moment the form is correctly completed with all the information.**
- Anyone appearing in your short film must be made aware of the use of their image.
- **24 hours before the end of the registration period for short films in Roda a TMB, no more filming permits will be given.**
- Any image taken of a transport user without consent, thereby infringing their rights, and which is subsequently reported may lead to the short film's disqualification,

without any liability on TMB's part.

- Film crews (including the technical and artistic crew and actors) must not consist of more than four people.
- No spotlights or sound booms are allowed. Neither are any other tools that may get in users' way.
- You are not allowed to film simulated scenes of a crime or other banned activities, such as a mugging, a fight or someone begging or busking inside a train, in a lobby or on a platform.
- You can check the Subtravelling website's query form to verify that any scenes you wish to shoot for the short film will be accepted.
- You are not allowed to disturb transport users, whether on platforms, in lobbies, in lifts, at bus stops or inside trains and buses.
- You must produce your permit whenever TMB staff so require.
- In any event, both on the Bus Turístic and the Cable Car, as well as on the metro and bus networks, the Passenger Regulations for Surface Transport (bus) and Railways (Metro) established by TMB must always be adhered to and can be consulted at:

2. Opening times

Bus, Montjuïc funicular railway or Montjuïc cable car

- You can shoot your film on Barcelona Bus Turístic and Montjuïc cable car any day of the week.
- Filming is not allowed inside the buses during peak hours, that is, from 8 am to 10 am and from 5 pm to 7 pm. Exceptions may be considered provided that the Bus operator considers it appropriate and depending on the bus line where you wish to film
- You may be refused permission by the operator of any of these transport systems where an event is being held, a large number of passengers is expected or an unexpected incident occurs.

Metro

- You can film on the **L9 Sud, L9 Nord, L10 SUD, L10 Nord and L11** automated lines and at stations with relatively few passengers on all other lines any day and at any time.
- Any situation or event that the metro operator deems problematic for filming at the station in question may result in the refusal or postponement of your permission for filming.
- **Filming is not allowed during peak hours, that is, from 8 am to 10 am and from 5 pm to 7 pm, at the following stations. Exceptions may granted where the metro operator deems fit.**

2. General rules for the Barcelona Bus Turístic service

- No smoking, eating or drinking is allowed on the bus.
- Pets are only allowed when carried in a prepared basket so they cannot soil the bus or cause nuisance to other users.
- No standing is allowed on the upper deck of the bus.
- No leaning out of the bus is allowed.
- Appropriate dress is mandatory (e.g. you cannot travel shirtless or in a bathing costume).
- Umbrellas must not be opened inside the bus.
- Passengers travelling with suitcases or prams should leave them in the central part of the bus, on the lower deck, next to the back staircase, and should keep an eye on them throughout their journey.
- People with wheelchairs will find an area reserved for them in the lower part of the buses.

3. Filming regulations for the Montjuïc cable car

- No smoking is allowed.
- No animals are allowed, except for guide dogs and those listed in the Passenger Regulations.
- Appropriate dress is mandatory (e.g. you cannot travel shirtless or in a bathing costume).
- Passengers must follow the cable car staff instructions at all times.
